

Keith Chadwick

Keith Chadwick is the President & CEO of United Methodist Homes, based in Binghamton, NY. In this role, he is responsible for the total operation of five campuses in New York and Pennsylvania, each offering a range of long-term care options. The Homes has a current resident population of more than 1,500 individuals, and employs more than 1,110 staff.

Chadwick earned his bachelor's and master's degrees from Binghamton University in Binghamton, NY. He has been with United Methodist Homes since 1976 and has been the President & CEO since 1980. He is also the Chairman and President of the United Methodist Homes Trust.

Chadwick is licensed as a nursing home administrator in New York and Pennsylvania. He served as the chairman of the New York Association of Homes and Services for the Aging (NYAHSAs) from 1990 to 1992, and as chairman of NYAHSAs Services from 1997 to 2001. He is a member of the American College of Nursing Home Administrators, the Broome County Long Term Care Administrators Group, the Community Foundation of South Central New York, the Local Emergency Planning Committee, the Lourdes Hospice Advisory Board, the Binghamton University Foundation Board and the Southern Tier Health Link Board.

Chadwick has been consistently recognized for his work in the long-term care field. He was presented with AAHSA's Meritorius Service Award in 1994, NYAHSAs's Thomas Clarke Award for Young Administrator of the Year in 1986 and NYAHSAs's Lawrence E. Larson Award in 2004. In 1995, he was the first Alumnus-in-Residence at Binghamton University's School of Education and Human Development.
