

GROWTH

ON THE RISE

Though Greater Binghamton's growth started with grassroots energy, its rapid advancement has captured the region's attention.

GRANTS & REVITALIZATIONS

A \$20 million New York State grant was awarded to Broome County to fund over 30 separate projects that cover quality-of-life improvements, property revitalization and more. Some of these projects include:

- Expansion of AgZeit, a local indoor agriculture startup company that grows organic produce year-round, which will create 83 jobs and utilize vacant buildings in Johnson City and Endicott.
- Creation of a Downtown Entertainment and Cultural Organization district in Binghamton.
- Renovation of 15 Avenue B in Johnson City, a former fire station, to create a mixed-use facility with apartments, brewery and restaurant.

Binghamton University School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences

Binghamton University's new School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences (SOPPS) is a research-focused professional school offering the Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) degree. It is located in a \$60 million building on Binghamton University's new, 11-acre Health Sciences Campus being developed in Johnson City, NY.






