



COVID-19 Recovery Team: Workforce & Talent Retention & Attraction Workgroup

Purpose

The purpose of this group is to connect businesses to resources for both short term and long term employment continuity; Prepare Broome County workers for the future employment needs (i.e. distance learning, how employers can regrow their workforce as they ramp back up and how to retain the key talent they don't want to lose); Communicate immediate temporary and permanent employment opportunities to job seekers and/or recently laid off employees. Schedule a job fair when the community can resume normal activity.

Meetings

The Workforce workgroup will initially convene weekly on Wednesdays at 10:00 am via video conference and this meeting frequency will be adjusted as the need requires. It is expected that this group to convene for a minimum of 12 months. The Workforce workgroup meetings will be organized and facilitated by the COO of the Greater Binghamton Chamber of Commerce. All 3 Recovery Teams will provide feedback and recommendations to the Response Cabinet. This will be a visible and active effort that will report progress on a regular basis to the community.
