Use the following tips and guidelines for your submission to help shine the best light on your nominee.

#### The Basics:

- Carefully read descriptions of each category and determine which one BEST fits the nominee
- The information provided on this submission is the only information the committee will review
- Be clear, concise and stay within the character count
- The deadline is Sunday, May 1, 2022 11:59pm EST
- Submit nominations for a YP Award here and Mentor to a YP here

## As you write, think about:

- What is the first thing that made you decide to nominate this person?
- How is this person different from others in a similar career?
- What are the first three adjectives that come to mind when thinking about this person?
- Do they go above and beyond at work/in their job? Do they do things outside their main responsibilities?
- Can you share something about one or more of their successes?
- Can you share how they overcome challenges?
- Can you share how the person is creative or innovative?
- How does this person contribute to the overall success of the team/group/business and our community?

Include the answers to as many of these questions in your submission!

#### **Additional Tips:**

Be as descriptive as possible when writing. Consider finding a strong writer to help edit and proofread for flow, grammar, and consistency.

### Example of a general statement:

I think that Joe is an exceptional employee. His work ethic is very high and combined with his personal skills I think that he is going to be seen as a leader in this industry or any industry he chooses.

#### **Example of a stronger statement:**

Joe delivers his enthusiasm and knowledge through well-planned career and professional development leadership-related programs to our students. More important are the connections he makes through vital 1:1 student appointments, where he builds students' confidence so they feel more comfortable with their new resources, independence and ability.

The key to a well-written nomination is providing the selection committee with specific information illustrating how the individual has excelled in their career AND the impact they have made in the community.
